He holds a PhD in science and technology studies (STS) at the sociological department, University of Gothenburg. He has been a researcher at the Mobility Studio at the Interactive Institute and a research assistant at the Viktoria Institute in the Mobile Informatics Program. His research focuses on sites of negotiation from the interactions within the laboratory to the mundane features of mobility.
