

Uppsala - Durham Seedcorn Fund 2020

Future Funding Opportunities

As per the application guidelines, it is expected that the seedcorn funding for research will lead to the submission of an external grant application and/or major research output.

Information about current external grant funding opportunities for cooperative projects between the UK and Sweden is shown below and may be useful to bear in mind when submitting an application for seedcorn funding.

From the UK side colleagues could potentially apply to:

- H2020/Horizon Europe (pending UK eligibility post-Brexit)
- Research Councils: e.g. there have been recent joint calls with Innovate UK (aerospace EUREKA call) and ESRC (migration and integration call with Swedish Research Council - [NordForsk](#)), though as usual the focus of future calls is at present unknown
- Wellcome Trust e.g. Swedish institutions would be eligible to be collaborators on Collaborative awards

- Leverhulme Trust: e.g. International Fellowships and study abroad studentships for UK nationals to work abroad

From the Sweden side colleagues could potentially apply to:

- Swedish Research Council: various international collaboration calls
- STINT (Swedish Foundation for INterantional Cooperation in Research and Higher Education): various international collaboration calls
- Royal Swedish Academy of Agriculture & Forestry: UFK Grants (Funding for exchanges with foreign researchers and research organisations)
