

Working life perspective and career paths – third cycle education/PhD studies

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Our research education is broad

- Uppsala University in 2020 (from annual report):
 - **2228** PhD students
 - 199 Research education subjects (forskarutbildningsämnen)
- Opportunities on the central level:
 - On-line Career Programme for Doctoral Students at Uppsala university (recent initiative (2021) by Unit for Career and Leadership in Academia)
 - PhD course Intelectual property and commercialization & Mentor4Research program (organized by UU Innovation)
- The main responsibility is placed on the PhD student, but should ideally be shared with the supervisors

Some recent local examples:

- Bringing in Alumni's as a key component:
 - Exit from postgraduate studies 1hp course at TekNat
 - Career day at EBC (inspired by <u>SLUs Career outside academia</u>)
- Organized by PhD Students for PhD students:
 - Digital AW organized by educational sciences doctoral council (UDR)
 - PhD Days annually at MedFarm, organized by both faculty doctoral councils (FDR & MDR)
- BUT for many PhD students:
 - the outside academia career path is completely ignored
 - the after research education career path is missing altogether

My top three tips:

- Reach out to your faculty doctoral council
 - If they are not already working on this → get involved and help motivate them!
 - We recommend at least one career activity per year
- Don't wait until the end of your final year
 - Start a dialogue with supervisors, touch upon during annual review perhaps?
 - Check out courses on the central level, build your "profile"
- Look up what activities the trade unions offer:
 - Naturvetarna in my case, life science careers
 - **SULF** more academic route
