Call for funding from Uppsala University's climate pot 2021

The Vice-Chancellor has earmarked SEK 2 million for a climate pot aimed at reinforcing and invigorating Uppsala University's efforts to reduce its climate impact. Applications are now welcome from employees, students and organisational units at Uppsala University.

Projects and initiatives with the potential to make a tangible contribution to lowering the University's climate impact can apply for grants of up to SEK 250,000.

Application contents: applications should contain a clear description of the project's goals and implementation, expected results, plan for follow-up and dissemination of results, and budget. See the instructions for further details.

Assessment criteria are specified in the instructions.

Applications must be received between 1 January and 28 February 2021 and should be submitted electronically to Environmental Director Karolina Kjellberg, karolina.kjellberg@uadm.uu.se

Applications must be signed by the head of department/equivalent at the applicant's department/equivalent.

The applications will be assessed by a group consisting of the Environmental Director, the Adviser to the Vice-Chancellor on Sustainable Development, a student representative and representatives of the three disciplinary domains.
