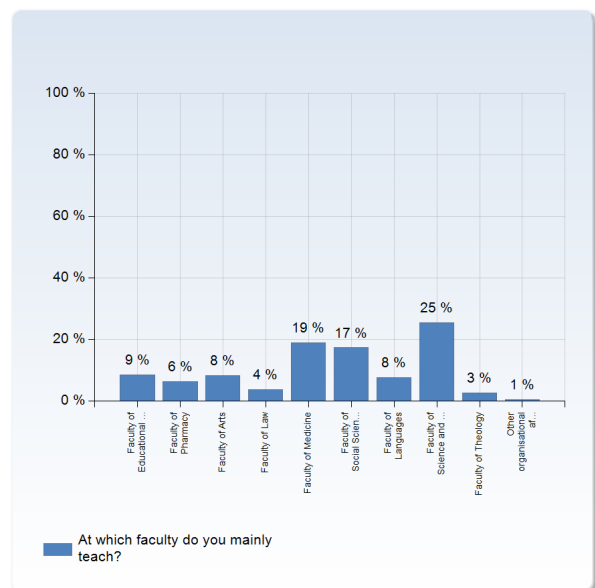

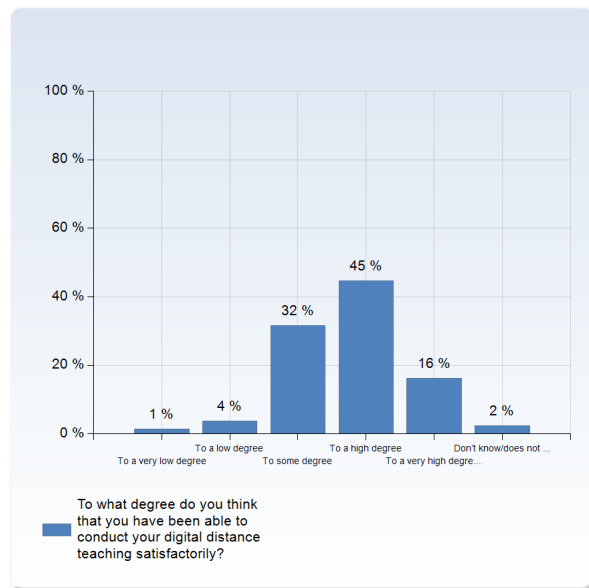

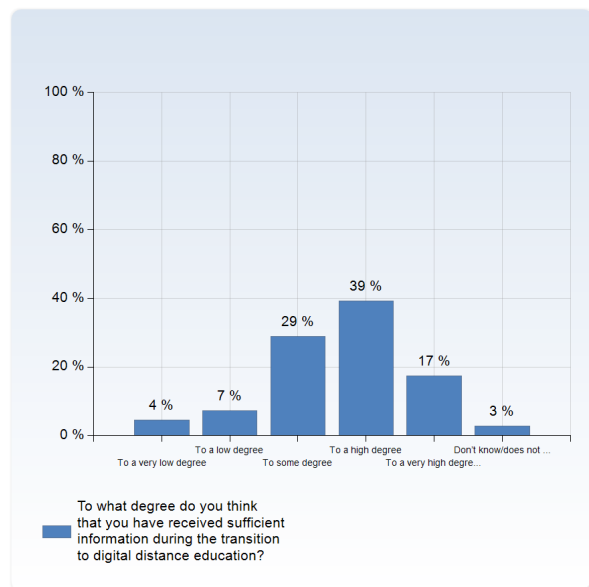

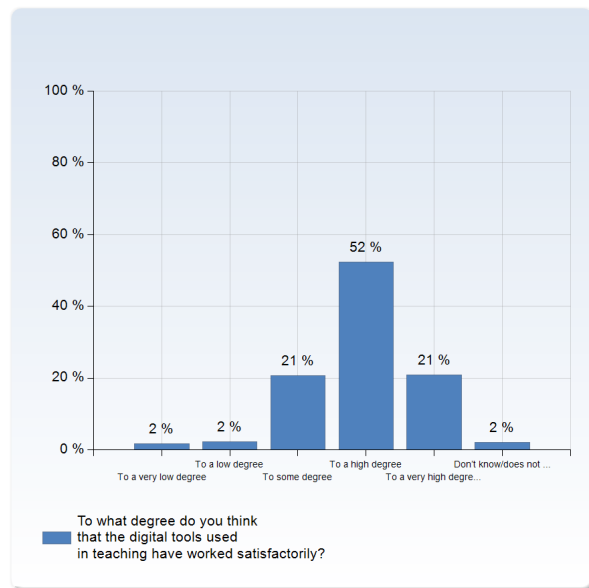

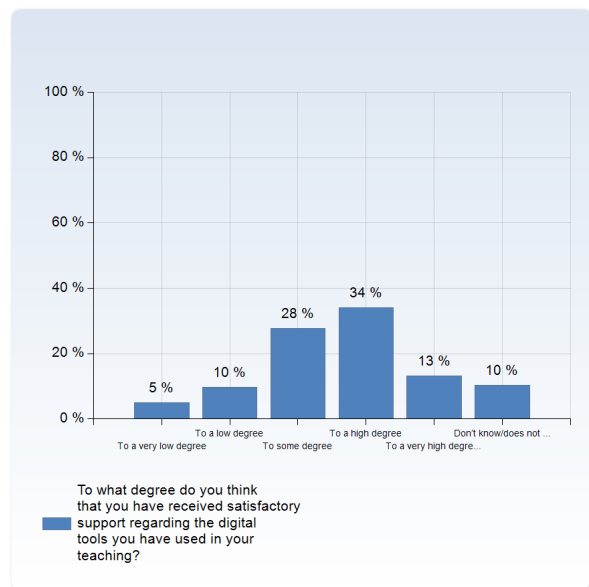

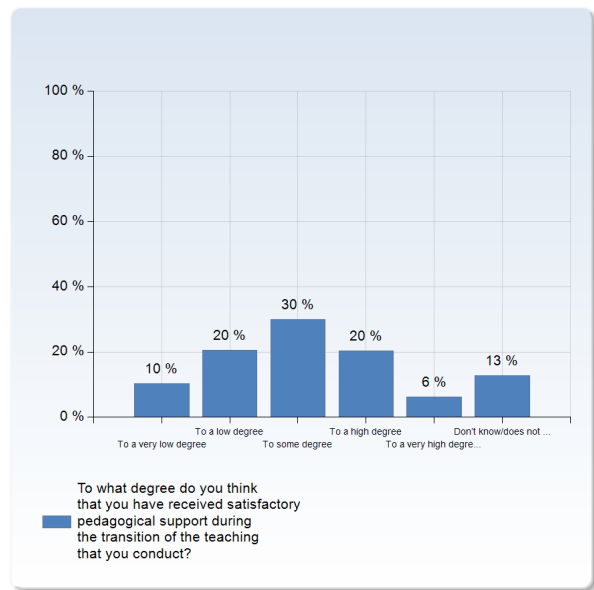

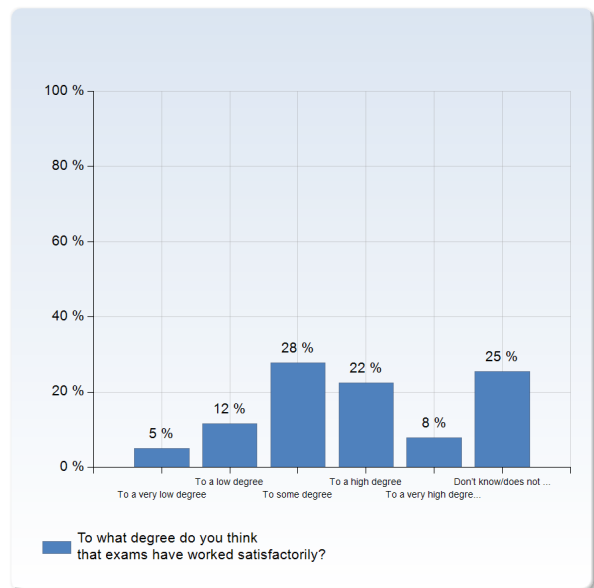

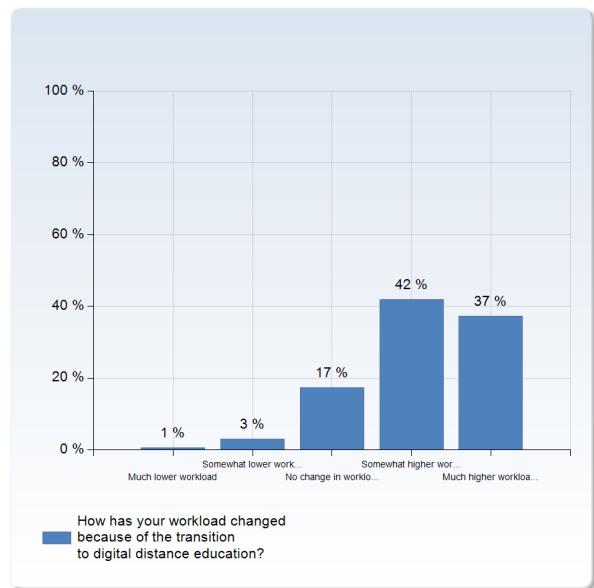

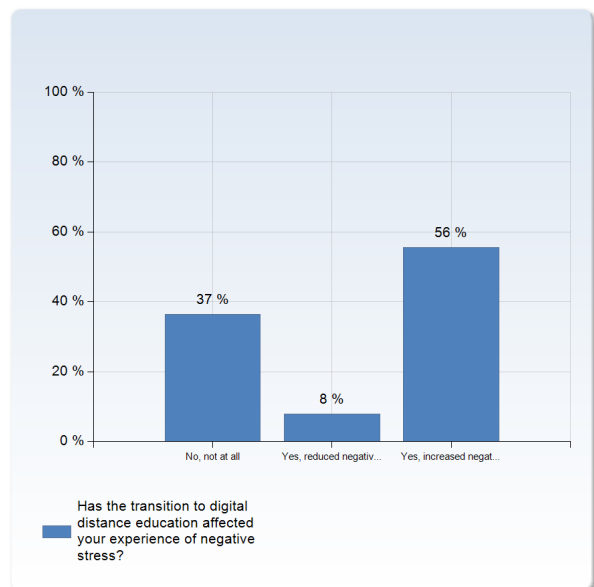
**9 How has your workload changed because of the transition to digital distance education?**
