

# Horizon Europe 2021-2027\* Programme Structure













#### **ERC**

- Projects with host institution in EU or Associated Country
- Highly competitive calls: success rate 11.4 %
- Ground-breaking, high gain/high risk research
- Frontier research in all fields of knowledge
- Bottom-up, no predetermined subjects/call titles
- ERC encourage:
  Innovative approaches, pioneering proposals, emerging fields, and, interdisciplinarity
- Evaluation criterion: Scientific excellence
- Individual support to PI + team
- International well-respected peer-review process





## **ERC Funding Scheme**

STG
Starting Grants
(2-7 years after PhD)

up to €1.5 Million for 5 years + €500,000 COG
Consolidator Grants
(7-12 years after PhD)

up to €2 Million for 5 years + €750,000 ADG
Advanced Grants
10 years' track-record

up to €2.5 Million for 5 years + €1 Million

#### **Proof-of-Concept -PoC**

bridging gap between research – earliest stage of marketable innovation €150,000 lump sum for ERC grantees

#### **Synergy Grant - SYG**

2-4 Principal Investigators up to €10 Million for 6 years + €4 Million





#### **MSCA**

- Programme for doctoral education and postdoctoral training
- A career development programme to facilitate researcher mobility
- Contribute to excellent research, boosting jobs, growth and investment
- Open to all domains of research and innovation, fully bottom-up manner
- Organisations from academic and non-academic sectors can receive funding

#### MSCA calls

- MSCA Doctoral Networks

Doctoral schools

International consortium with members from at least three EU Member States and/or Associated Countries

Consortium formed to hire and train Ph.D.-students with a specific training subject

- MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship

Open to researchers holding a Ph.D.

Any nationality, including researchers wishing to reintegrate in Europe






## General advice: Proposal writing

- Make a career plan
- Excellent project idea + Excellent proposal
- Start in time
- Read documents
- Make the correct panel choise
- Answer the questions: Why this project? Why now? Why you?
- Avoid beeing too technical/detailed
- Use support such as peers and Grants Office
- Do not give up apply again and again and use your previous evaluation/s
- Work as expert/evaluator
