

Matariki Leadership Initiative 2021

Crucial to the success of academic research and education is the support of competent, updated and well-managed professional services. In the spirit of strengthening these support functions, four institutions within MNU are now launching The Matariki Leadership Initiative 2021.

PURPOSE

The Matariki Leadership Initiative 2021 aims to further develop the proficiency of the managers that participate as well as providing a space for networking, collegial learning and development of new ideas within the areas of leadership and professional services.

FORMAT

The Matariki Leadership Initiative 2021 will manifest in a mixed learning and exchange programme. This will include four lectures from research experts within leadership and management, one live on site and three pre-recorded, as well as four live sessions conducted via zoom. The participants will watch a lecture and then attend a reflection-learning session via zoom where they can discuss the content of the lecture and compare their own experiences to that of their colleagues from the other universities. The participating managers will reflect in smaller groups of colleagues that work within the same area of expertise in professional services but represent different institutions.
